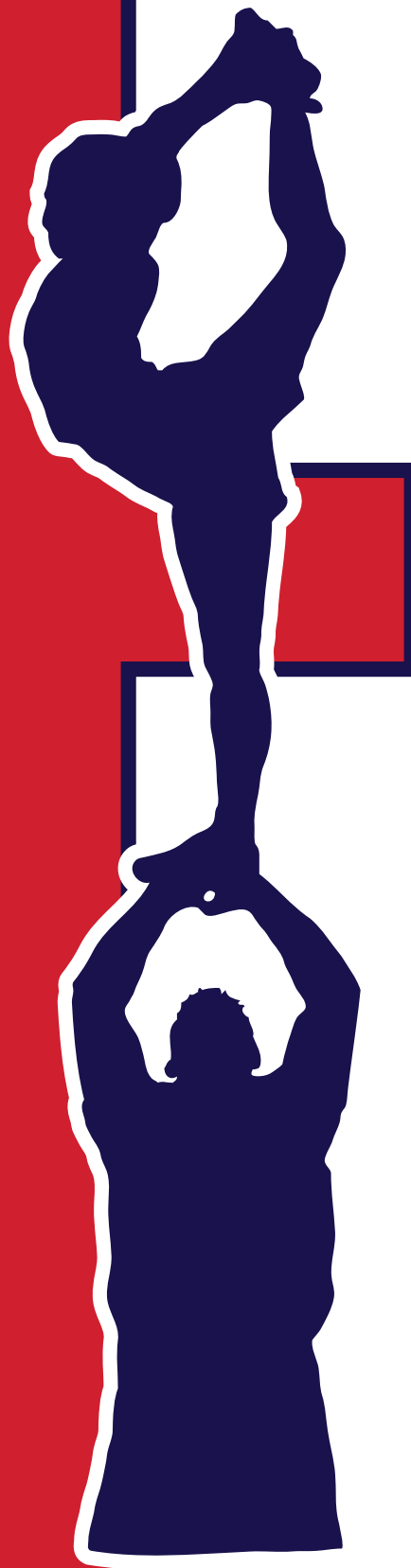

CCA COMPETITION PHILOSOPHY

Our Philosophy

The first and most important responsibility of a school (any age) and college cheerleader is to SUPPORT the athletic teams and raise and maintain overall school spirit and loyalty. All competition is secondary to this main goal. In fact, competition participation for school teams is a reward for a job well done. Promotional activities or practice for competition at the expense of team support means that priorities are out of order.

AllStar and Empower teams' first and most important responsibility is to develop leadership and teach life lessons to each participant. Giving 100 % to all competition efforts and always putting TEAM first should be their highest priority.

Our Purpose

- To offer a place for competition for those athletes who have selected cheerleading as their extra-curricular athletic activity just as all other sports are able to do with every event.
- To offer an outlet to recognize and reward excellence and hard work in the Christian cheerleading environment for school, home school, college, AllStar and Empower teams.
- To give Christian cheerleaders and Christian/faith-based teams a place to compete with their peers without intimidation because of dress, moves, music and other Biblical standards of behavior.
- To afford the opportunity to meet and fellowship with teams from other cities, states and regions of the country. This allows for development of lasting friendships and provides increased networking opportunities, representing the Lord Jesus Christ.
- To honor and give pre-eminence to the Lord Jesus Christ in all activities and events.
- To offer affordable competition with individual and team rewards and with nationals, the opportunity to compete for college scholarships.

Our Professionalism

- All rules, costs, judging sheets and competition guidelines will be distributed to participants well in advance of all competition events.
- All music is approved in advance for all competitors in accordance with the music, moves and dress policy which may be found on the CCA website (www.cheercca.com). All music should have proper legal licensing. Music must be submitted one month in advance to info@cheercca.com in an mp3 or wav format. All routines, dress, and moves must also follow the other rules in the MMD policy.
- American Association of Cheerleaders Coaches and Administrators (AACCA) safety rules for school, empower and college teams will be in effect and strictly adhered to and enforced. AllStar teams must abide by USASF guidelines and safety rules. Besides the required team spotters, the competition administration will provide floor spotters for additional safety.
- All events will be held on an official cheer competition foam bonded cheer floor. Nationals performance floor and tumbling strip warm up will be held on a regulation spring floor. Most floors will be 54' x 42'. At smaller events, floors may be slightly smaller. Stunt team, solos, duos and trios will be held on the same floor as the team events. At most events, mat rehearsal will be allowed as well as warm up on another floor.
- Competition administration will provide experienced, qualified safety, deduction, difficulty and technical judges as well as timekeepers and announcers. All technical judges must certify that they are not connected with any participating school/team in any way to avoid any semblance of impropriety.

CCA EMPOWER DIVISION

This division was created by CCA to meet the growing needs of cheerleading in the recreation league, community, and church teams that are being organized all around the country. Often these teams have nowhere to go for guidance in the way to set up and run cheer programs. They need training, resource information, safety guidelines and ministry assistance in general. They truly want to be a part of a cheerleading ministry outside of the school or all star setting and create their own niche in the industry. Empower teams are the CCA answer to this desire. They are not school teams and yet not all star teams and want to compete with teams in similar situations on their level. Empower is exactly the ministry that is a perfect fit for many. It may be an exciting ministry for you!

What qualifies you for the EMPOWER category?

- A team formed under the auspices of a church for the purpose of providing the activity of cheerleading or praise performance dance as an outreach for their church youth
- May or may not cheer at church league type ball games
- Participants do not have to be a member of the church or attend the sponsoring church as the mission of this type program is to reach the unchurched and bring in new people using the common interest of cheerleading for the purpose of evangelism and discipleship
- A recreation league formed from community/area for the purpose of cheerleading. Formed under a specific rec league organization for the purpose of cheerleading. Almost always cheers for a rec league team games but not required.
- A neighborhood or community group formed for the purpose of giving wholesome athletic opportunities for boys and girls, and cheers at CCA Competition events and game cheer only!

CCA will assist in setting up these teams for training, uniforms, competitions, securing coaches, etc as needed. There is not a membership fee to be a part of Empower. Teams sign up for camps and competitions the same as other categories/divisions and pay the same fees. Most assistance listed above is free. Some may require paying staff expense only for assistance.

Tiny Level:	Stunts: Below shoulder level only. (thigh/floor/gut) Tumbling: Rolls, Cartwheels, Round-offs only
Level One:	Stunts: Below shoulder level. Elevator at shoulder level w/front & back spot allowed for building/cradling Tumbling: Rolls, Cartwheels, Round-Offs , Front and Back Walkovers Only
Level Two:	Stunts: Shoulder Level Stunts. No extended stunts except double based ext w/spotter front & back; hitch ok Tumbling; Standing Back Handsprings, Running Back Handsprings and series
Level Three:	Stunts: All stunts allowed by AACCA for high school Tumbling: All Tumbling allowed by AACCA for high school. NOTE: Empower Jr Lev 3 MAY do basket tosses because ages in Jr Div may include participants above JH

Solo, Duo, Trio, & Stunt-A-Thon
School, Empower, and All Star solo, duo, and trio participants compete together. School/Empower will compete separately from Allstars. During Stunt-A-Thon using AACCA or USASF rules as applicable AS will compete in the highest level allowed for the age group in Solo/Duo and Stunt-a-Thon

CCA DIVISION REQUIREMENTS

SCHOOL DIVISIONS (USING AACCA SAFETY RULES)

Non-Music

Cheers, Stunts, Jumps, Tumbling if desired, but no music or sound effects allowed.
Minimum time 1:00; Maximum time 2:00

Cheer/Music

Cheers, Stunts, Jumps, Tumbling if desired. Music/Dance allowed but must be approved in advance based on the CCA Music Moves and Dress policy.
Maximum Routine time: 2:30 Maximum music time in total 1:30. No minimum for music portion or cheer portion. 1:00 minimum for total routine. Time penalties apply.

All Music

Cheers, Stunts, Jumps, Tumbling if desired. Music/Dance allowed but must be approved in advance based on the CCA Music Moves and Dress policy.
Maximum routine time is 2:30 of which all should be music.

Non-Tumbling

Routine may be Non-Music, Cheer/Music or All Music.
No Tumbling is allowed. Stunting may be done at any level according to AACCA rules.
Time limits follow same rules as regular NM, C/M or AM routines above.

Novice

Routine may be Non-Music, Cheer/Music or All Music.
All skills allowed however levels are as follows:
-No tumbling more advanced than walkovers. (no bhs etc)
-No stunting above shoulder level. Exception: Elevator allowed with front and back spot/assist
-No twisting dismounts
Time limit follow the same rules as regular NM, C/M, or AM routines above

Non-Building

Routine may be Non-Music, Cheer/Music or All Music.
All skills allowed except for stunting. Routine must consist of only ground bound skills
Tumbling skills allowed by AACCA rules
Time limits follow the same rules as regular NM, C/M, or AM routines above

COED

In all divisions except varsity divisions, coed teams and all girl teams will compete against each other, having one male constitutes coed in varsity division.

SOLO, DUO, TRIO, and Stunt-A-Thon

(Using AACCA & USASF as applicable- AS & School/Emp have separate division for Stunt-A-Thon and AS compete at the highest level allowed by age division.)

Solo (only offered at Classics and Nationals)

All skills allowed. School, Empower, and Allstar competitors all compete in the same division by grade in school and use AACCA safety rules. Routines may be all or part music as desired
1:00 verbal Christian testimony required. 1:00 cheer routine required. No minimum time.
Solo Tumbling - all tumbling skills as allowed by AACCA and up to level 5 AS (No Double Fulls Allowed)
Solo Non-Tumbling - No tumbling beyond round-offs/cartwheels. Divisions divide the same way as tumbling
Sch/Emp & AS divisions are as follows: Elem, Int, Jh, Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior. Males/Females compete in the same division

Duo & Trio (only offered at Classics and Nationals)

Same division, age, level requirements as listed for solo. School/Empower and Allstars compete in the same divisions. No separate division for Males/Females.
Divisions is determined by the competitor who is in the highest grade
Duo/ Trio Tumbling - all tumbling skills as allowed by AACCA and up to level 6 AS
Duo/ Trio Non-Tumbling - No tumbling beyond round-offs/cartwheels. Divisions divide the same way as tumbling
Sch/Emp & AS divisions are as follows: Elem, Int, Jh, Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior.

Stunt-A-Thon (only offered at Classics and Nationals)

For school stunt teams, all stunts are allowed by AACCA rules (Elem, Int, JH, JV, Varsity)
For Empower stunt teams, all stunts are allowed up to highest Empower level allowed for age using AACCA rules (Tiny, Min, Youth, Jr, Sr)
For Allstar teams all stunts are allowed up to the highest level within age groups according to USASF guidelines (Tiny, Mini, Youth, JR, SR)
For coed one male makes a stunt team coed except in lower/younger AS divisions which allow males without being coed according to regular USASF rules

Empower (Uses AACCA safety rules as well as special empower level rules)

Empower divisions have the same guidelines as schools regarding team size. Empower has only one category and is allowed to be all music, Non-Music, or part music. Empower routines are 2:30 max and 1:00 minimum.
Empower levels are NOT like allstar levels. see below
LEVEL 1: Stunts- below shoulder level. Elevator with front and back spot are allowed. Tumbling - Nothing above Round-offs
LEVEL 2: Stunts- No extended stunts except double base ext w/back and front spot. Tumbling - max BHS
LEVEL 3 :Stunts- All stunts allowed by AACCA. All tumbling allowed by AACCA. (NOTE: Baskets are allowed in Empower JR 3)

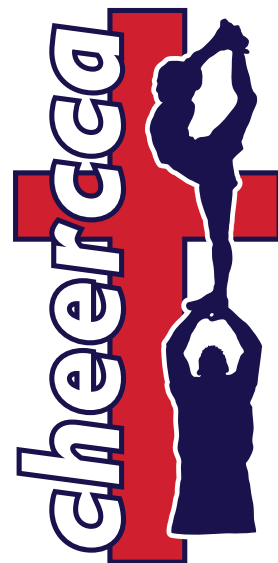
AllStars (Uses USASF Guidelines and age grids)

Dance/Pom (Uses AACCA safety rules) 2:00 routine max. Poms not required but allowed. same music, moves, and dress policy

Mascot (Uses AACCA safety rules) 2:30 routine max. Same music, moves, and dress policy as all divisions, props allowed

College (Uses AACCA safety rules) 2:30 routine max using all, none or a portion as music. CCA Music, moves, and dress policy applies See college score

ANY Violation of these rules will result in DISQUALIFICATION without a refund. Violations will be judged by competition judges and competition director(s). ALL music must be approved by the CCA Office ONE MONTH PRIOR to competing..

This form must be signed and dated by coach once for all events for each season one month prior to first event.

MUSIC

All words/phrases should be positive and uplifting, not negative, degrading or mocking to other teams/schools. They should not be "slashing" and unsportsmanlike. No degrading words that undermine authority (police, parental, political, etc), glorify or legitimize illegal substance, drugs, or activities. This also includes legal substances such as tobacco and alcohol. No sexual references or innuendos. No lewd, suggestive words (or gestures) or specific references to private parts.Nothing representative of the drug or gang culture allowed. No references to violence, murder, etc. No violent screams. Special attention is required to be sure that God, Jesus Christ or Deity is not referred to in any way that might be less than holy and pure and is lowered to the level of humanity. Upbeat Christian contemporary music is allowed and WELCOMED!

Upbeat secular music is allowed, as long as, it meets the criteria mentioned above; however, we do ask that you not use ANY portion of a song if the song in its entirety does not fit the above guidelines (i.e. using a verse of a song in your mix with acceptable words but the chorus has unacceptable lyrics). The reason for asking this is so that we do not come across as endorsing either the artist or the song when it is recognizable to the audience. This would be detrimental to the testimony of CCA and will not be allowed. PLEASE NOTE! Songs will be considered on a case by case basis. If you are unsure of the status of any song, artist and/or lyrics, contact the CCA office. NOTE: You are responsible to verify that all songs used in your music are licensed and fulfil copyright laws. CCA is not responsible for the playing of unlicensed music. CCA licenses through ASCAP and CCLI.

ALL MUSIC MUST BE APPROVED WELL IN ADVANCE OF COMPETITION (4- 6 weeks is suggested in order to allow time for changes if music is not approved). Approval may be secured by mailing a CD to the CCA office (be sure it is a COPY) or emailing music to info@cheercca.com as a .wav or .mp3 file. You will be notified by a phone call or email of approval or changes that need to be made within 10 days of CCA's receipt of the music. NOTE: When submitting music, please list songs and artists used so that we can expedite the review process. While reviewing this information you will most likely be able to determine if lyrics will be accepted or not. Failure to meet the MUSIC policy will result in DISQUALIFICATION without refund.

MOVES

No moves done during music or non-music parts of your routine shall have lewd or suggestive movements. No pelvic thrusts, body waves and/or rolls, extreme hip gyrations or upper body movements that have sexual connotations. No bending with bottom facing audience allowed. No sticking out tongue or any facial expressions or movements of a sexual nature. If there is any doubt at all that your routine moves are not in line with this policy, you should send a video to the Competition Director at the CCA offices ONE MONTH ahead of competition date for approval. NOTE: The Moves Rules will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. It has been brought to our attention that some moves may have been missed in the past; however, going forward if there are obvious violations they will be identified by judges. CCA WILL BE VERY STRICT in enforcement of this policy. Violations of the MOVES policy will result in DISQUALIFICATION without refund.

DRESS

CCA dress code is modesty. Length of skirt can be determined by your own school or all star program's dress policy. Competition judging will not be done in regard to skirt length. Modesty in undergarments is critical. Please be sure that undergarments cover properly and supportive sports bras are worn. No bare midriff uniforms or practice outfits are allowed. Tank tops are allowed, but no completely bare shoulders. Tops should be modest and not extremely low cut or brief. If you have any question about tops or other clothing, in order to meet the dress code, it is suggested that body suits be worn under any questionable tops. Skirts should be long and loose enough for modesty, even when stunting, jumping and tumbling. Skirts must completely cover all undergarments, hips, etc. when standing. Violations will result in requiring uniforms or practice clothes to be changed and may even result in a disqualification without refund.

Other event bids at the discretion of event producer (also depends on event size) Uniform discounts. Cash awards from Sponsors. All awards at the discretion of the event producer are subject to change due to participation levels and sponsorship changes. SOLO, DUO, and TRIO AWARDS

Classics

Trophies or plaques, discounts for spirit accessories, medallions. Awards may vary at the discretion of the event producer.

Nationals

Additionally solos only are awarded college or high school / gym scholarships at the discretion of event producer. More than \$1,000,000 in scholarship money, awards, discounts, trophies and prizes is available. Not all of this money is always awarded and not all of it is used, (based on participation); however, it is available at the discretion of the colleges and event producer. Scholarships are awarded in varying amounts to winning individuals and Cheer Scholars based on availability and certain criteria from sponsoring colleges and universities.

CHEER SCHOLAR AWARDS

Nationals Only

These awards are given from nominations and evaluations of academic performance combined with Christian service. Cheer Scholar nominees must have GPA of 3.0 or higher in order to be nominated. See nomination form for qualifications. These awards are given to cheerleaders; however, no cheering skills are judged in deciding the Cheer Scholar Awards. Junior and Senior Winners will be given a scholarship to one or more of the participating colleges. Most scholarships have specific requirements from individual colleges. Cheer Scholar nominees (3.0 GPA and above) will be awarded after each team performance on Friday. For applicants below 11th grade, other tuition scholarships or prizes may be awarded in lieu of college scholarships, depending on ranking. The National Cheer Scholar of the Year, in all Divisions, will be awarded Saturday evening with team Finals. CAUTION: PLEASE BE SURE TO NOMINATE ALL ELIGIBLE CHEERLEADERS AND VERIFY THOSE NOMINATED WITH A CCA OFFICIAL NO LATER THAN JAN 5, 2018. SPECIAL AWARD Nationals ONLY

There will be a special "SPIRIT OF COMPETITION" award given. This will be voted on by participating teams and must be turned in by noon on Saturday at the CCA Spirit Store. Each team participating will be given a ballot and should vote for the team they feel best exemplifies the "spirit" of the CCA CHRISTIAN CHEER NATIONALS WEEKEND. Separate Spirit of Competition Awards for Schools/Empower and Allstars. GRAND CHAMPION AWARDS

JUDGING

There will be separate certified, qualified professional AACC Certified safety judges as well as Deduction and Difficulty. Judges' decisions are final regarding disqualification, timing, safety deductions and all other aspects of judging.

Good sportsmanship and Christian conduct should be displayed at all times. Squads should cheer with each other during the routines as a game crowd would. Fans and participants should refrain from talking or moving around during any team's performance other than to cheer with the performing squad. The Competition officials reserve the right to remove anyone who does not follow these rules of conduct. NO smoking, tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs are allowed at the event or in the venue at any time. Unsportsmanlike conduct of any kind during any of the event activities, at the discretion of the judges and competition officials, will be grounds for disqualification without refund.
