

Dear Coach:

Unfortunately, we are going to **have to cancel** the **BLUE RIDGE CLASSIC this weekend in Lynchburg, VA**. We have waited as long as possible to make this decision, but the weather is definitely on its way. The **Governor of the state of Virginia has declared a state of emergency** already for the area for Friday and Saturday. The forecast (and has already started in some of the surrounding areas) is calling for **6-10" of snow as well as ice, freezing rain and blizzard conditions** with a high of 32 degrees for both days. Many participants have already called to let us know of even worse conditions in their areas and that they are unable to make it. Actually, almost half of the participating teams have already made that call to us.

This is the **first time in the history of CCA that we have had to cancel** an event due to weather. We have had some rough circumstances and conditions in which it started to snow during events but we have never had to cancel. We certainly did not desire to cancel this event, but know **it is in the interest of safety for all involved**.

We outlined our cancellation policy in a previous email. We are able to **reschedule this event for Saturday, February 27th**. It will be at **Lynchburg Christian Academy in Lynchburg** at their amazing gym facilities. Everything will be the same; schedule, etc. For those of you who are looking to this event for Nationals discounts, we will extend your time to pay your final balance until Feb 29 (Monday after the event) so you will know the final amount to pay after discounts. We may even pick up a few other schools for Feb 27th who could not attend on this date.

Thanks for understanding our situation. Please have a safe and warm weekend. **We will see you on the 27th and again at Nationals**.
